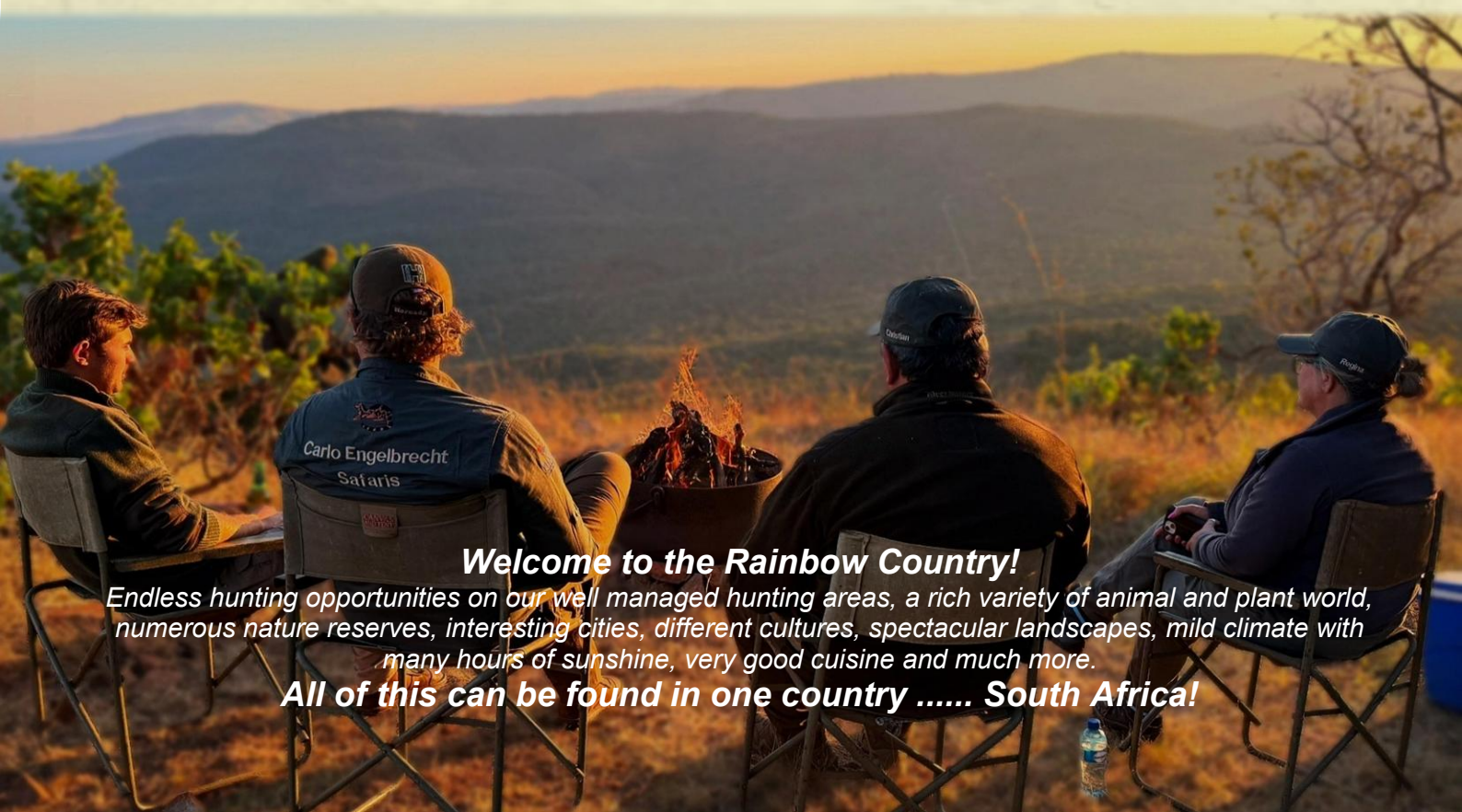

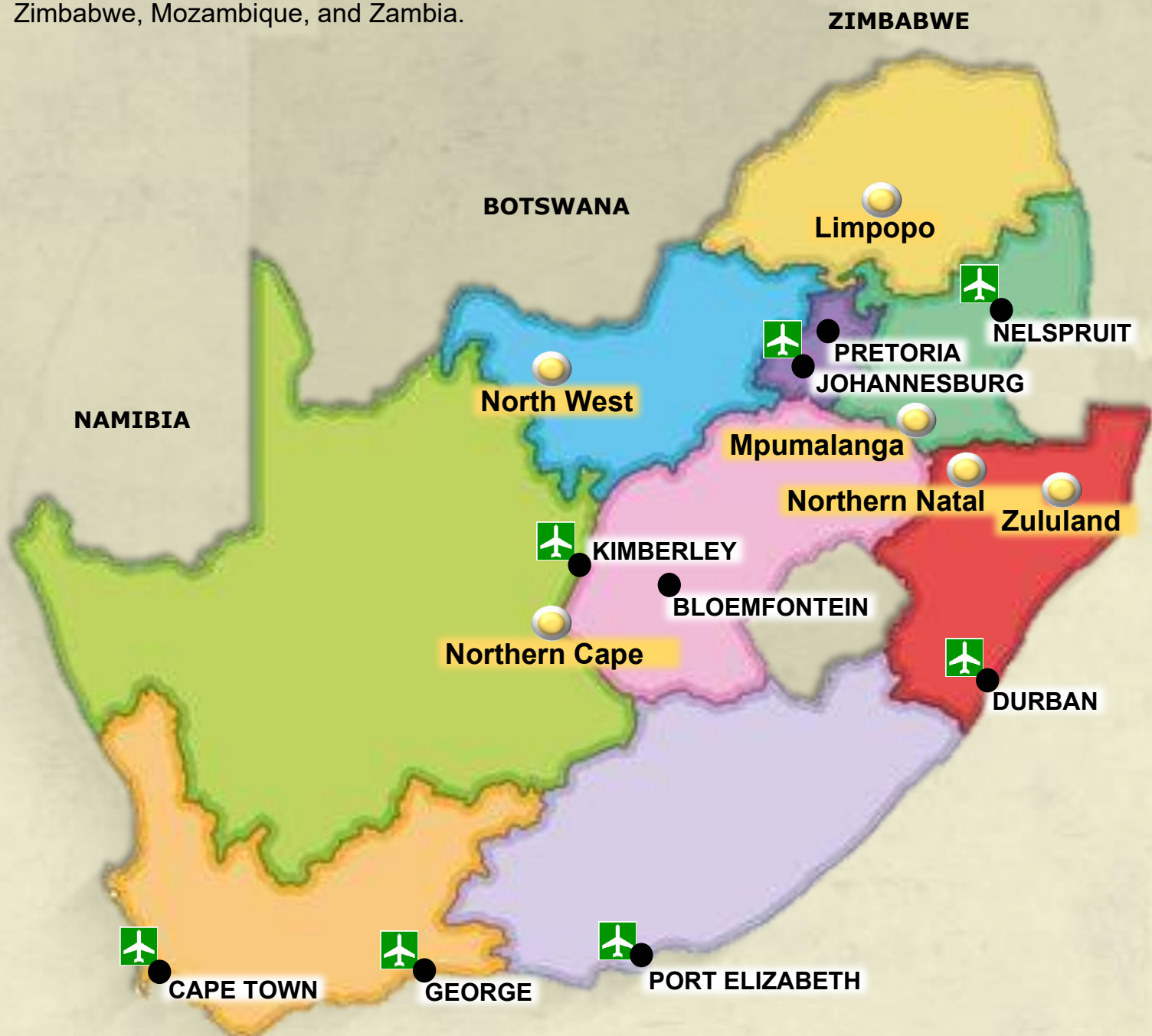
Hunting Information

From February to November, Africa comes alive - and so does the hunt. We offer thrilling trophy hunts and exhilarating wingshooting for almost all classic African species, including dangerous game such as Buffalo, Hippopotamus, Leopard, Elephant, and Lion, across some of South Africa's most iconic hunting regions.

Our primary hunting areas are located in KwaZulu-Natal, with concessions spanning up to 65,000 hectares of untamed wilderness. These landscapes stretch from the dense, subtropical bush of Zululand near the Indian Ocean, across the rolling hills of northern Natal, into the dry bushveld of Limpopo, parts of the North West Province near the Botswana border, and onward to the vast, open spaces of the Northern Cape near Kimberley. Each region offers its own challenges, beauty, and unforgettable encounters.

Beyond the hunt, adventure continues. A wide selection of day excursions and multi-day journeys allows you to combine your safari with a memorable holiday for the entire family.

For those seeking even greater horizons, we also arrange exceptional hunts for dangerous game and antelope in Namibia, Botswana, Zimbabwe, Mozambique, and Zambia.

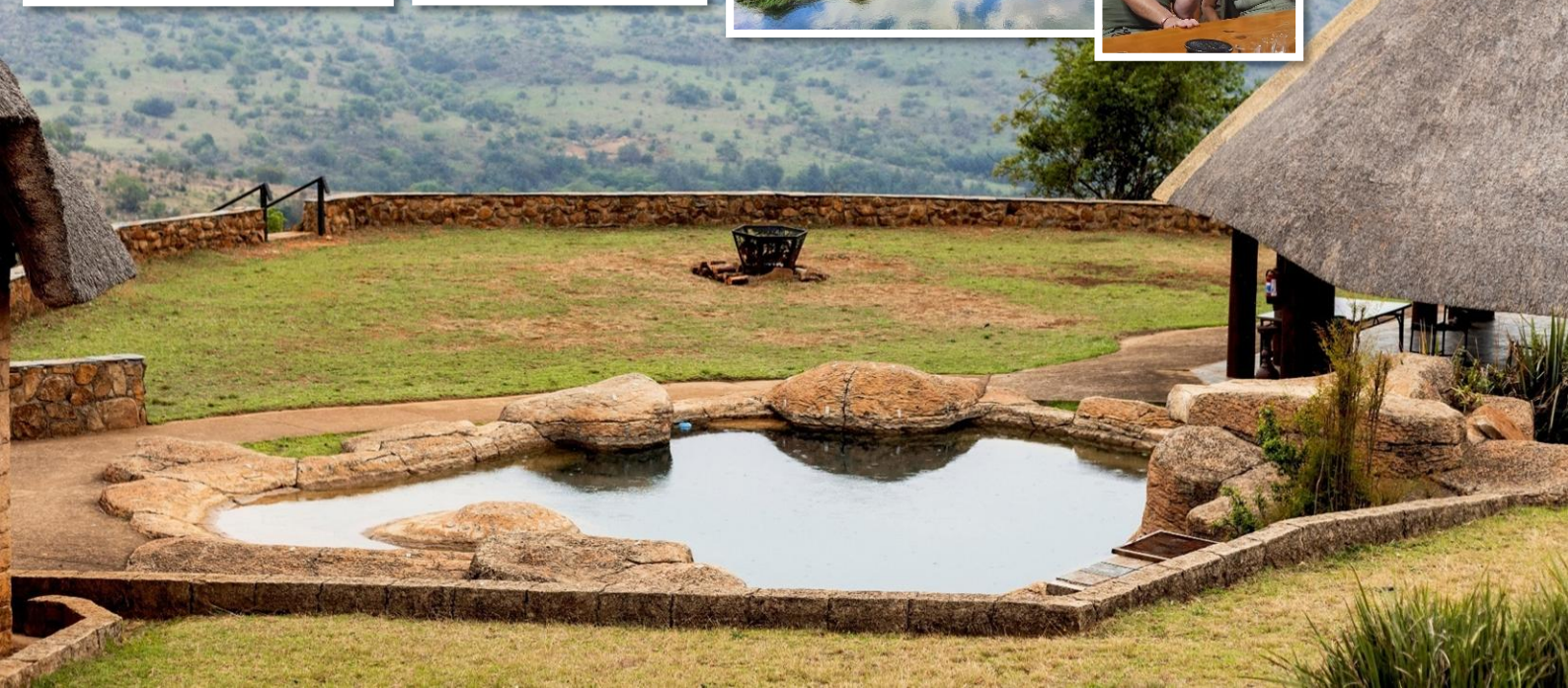
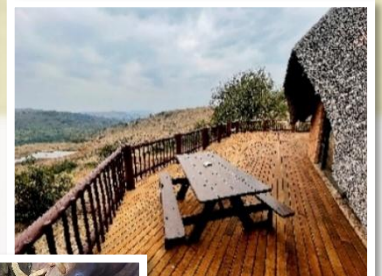
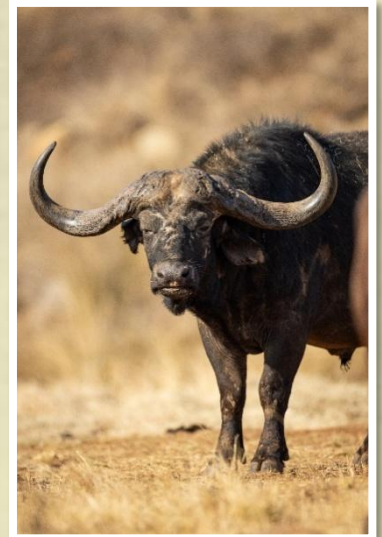

HUNTING AREA: Northern Natal

Located at 1,300 meters above sea level, the Northern Natal hunting area offers open grasslands, mountain scenery, rivers, and wetlands that provide excellent habitat for a wide range of game and birdlife.

The area lies approximately four hours southeast of Johannesburg International Airport and serves as the main base for Carlo Engelbrecht Safaris.

Hunters can pursue large herds of Eland, Blackwildebeest, Blesbuck and Springbuck, as well as more elusive species such as Common- and Mountain Reedbuck, Grey Duiker, and the elusive Bushpig. White Rhino, Buffalo and Hippo are also present, along with very good opportunities for Bird hunting.

HUNTING AREA: Zululand

Often called the Eden of Africa, Zululand is a land of deep valleys, misty mountains, and open savannas draped in subtropical acacia bush. It is a place where wilderness still feels untouched and timeless.

Zululand is home to some of Africa's most beautiful antelope - Nyala, Bushbuck, and Kudu - along with abundant Impala, Blue wildebeest, Zebra, and Warthog, offering endless hunting possibilities.

One of our primary buffalo hunting areas, Zululand also sees Elephant, Black Rhino, Leopard, and the occasional Lion moving quietly through our hunting blocks, adding to its true African romance.

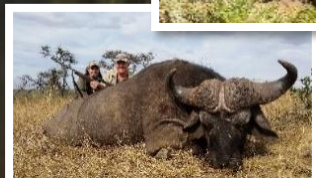
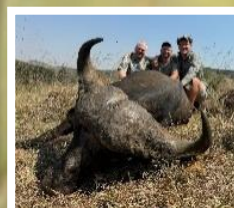
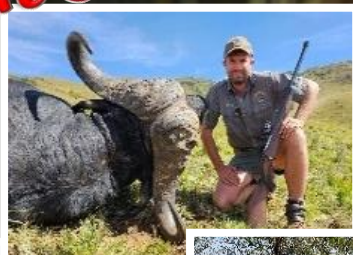

Reduction / Culling Hunts

One of the key aspects of game farm management is the control of game numbers. Each year, we conduct comprehensive game counts across all our hunting areas to determine the carrying capacity of each property. Based on these results, we establish how many animals need to be removed to maintain healthy populations and balanced ecosystems.

While some animals are hunted as trophy animals, the majority are culled as part of responsible wildlife management.

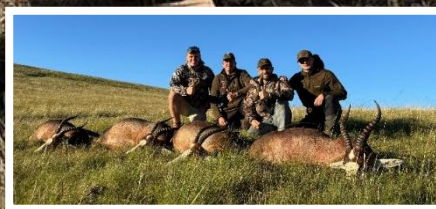

11 Day Safari Package

Safari Program:

Day 1:

Arrival in Johannesburg. Transfer to the Northern Natal hunting area.

Day 2 to Day 4:

Spend three hunting days in Northern Natal. This area lies at approximately 1,300 meters above sea level and is characterized mainly by open grasslands with hills and mountains. For this reason, it is home primarily to grazing species such as Blesbuck, Hartebeest, Reedbuck, Mountain Reedbuck, Sable, both Wildebeest species, and large herds of Eland. Dangerous game such as Hippo, Buffalo and White Rhinoceros are also found here.



Day 5 to Day 7:

Spend three hunting days in Zululand. On the Morning of Day 5, we drive 140 km southeast To the Zululand hunting area. This region lies at approximately 400 meters above sea level.

With its typical subtropical Zululand acacia bush, the area also features a wide variety of landscapes, including high mountains, densely vegetated valleys, and open savannahs. In addition to plains game such as nyala, impala, and warthog, the area is also home to Hippos, Crocodiles, Elephants, Buffalo and White- and Black Rhinoceros



Day 8:

We leave the hunting area and travel toward the Indian Ocean to St. Lucia, South Africa's largest natural estuarine lake, is renowned for its unique coastal vegetation, rich birdlife, and endless beaches. The 2,500 km² park was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1999.

Day 9 to Day 10:

We enjoy a two-hour drive through the lake system, observing Hippos, Crocodiles, And other wildlife, gaining wonderful impressions of the nature reserve. We then travel north to Cape Vidal.

We enjoy the beach, swim in the warm Indian Ocean, visit Cape Vidal, take a boat cruise on Lake St. Lucia, and visit a crocodile park.

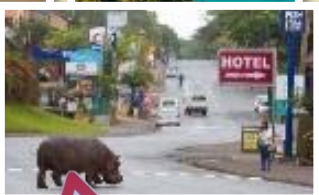
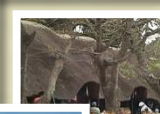
Day 11:

Transfer to Durban or Richards Bay Airport for the domestic flight to Johannesburg. In the evening, the journey continues back to Europe.

Tigerfishing in Zululand

About half an hour from the Zululand hunting camp lies the Pongolapoort Dam, also known as Lake Jozini. The lake is renowned for its excellent population of Tigerfish. Covering approximately 16,000 hectares, it is situated directly against the Lebombo Mountains.

While fishing is good year-round, the best time to target tigerfish is from August to May. The area surrounding the lake boasts a fascinating diversity of plant and animal life, including Rhinoceros, Hippos, Crocodiles, various antelope species, and over 500 Bird species.

The cost for this is € 450 per half day, including boat charter, fishing, equipment, and skipper (maximum 5)



Deep-sea fishing

In addition, to hunting in the Zululand area, we also offer day trips to the Indian Ocean, for example. Departing from the coastal town of St. Lucia, anglers can target species such as Marlin, Sailfish, Shark, Mackerel and Tuna.

The cost for this is € 900 per day, including boat charter, fishing, equipment, and skipper (maximum 4 anglers).



Wingshooting

We also offer wingshooting in various regions of South Africa. In the Free State and KwaZulu-Natal, passionate shotgun hunters will find excellent opportunities to achieve very good daily bags. These hunting areas are located approximately three hours' drive south of Johannesburg. In and along maize, sunflower, and grain fields, a wide variety of bird species can be hunted, including Francolin, Pigeons, Egyptian geese, and Guinea fowl.

Wing shooting is possible at different times of the year; however, the planting and harvesting cycles of the fields must be taken into account.

HUNTING AREA: Limpopo

Located about 400 km north of Johannesburg International Airport, our Limpopo hunting area lies in South Africa's dry northern bushveld. The arid climate and occasional rainless seasons create challenging conditions, producing tough, well-adapted game.

This area is ideal for the selective hunter seeking rare species such as African Civet, Honey badger, Brown hyena, and Small-spotted Genet. Selected concessions also offer excellent Warthog, as well as regional species including Limpopo Bushbuck, Klipspringer and Sharpe's Grysbok.

These varied landscapes provide ideal habitat for species such as Bontebok, Oryx (gemsbok), Lechwe, and all color variants of Springbuck.

For hunters seeking rare and specialized species, the Northern Cape is also the place to pursue Aardwolf, African wildcat, and Barbary sheep, making this region a unique and rewarding hunting destination.

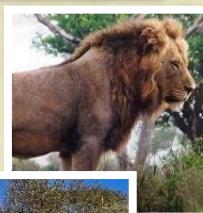

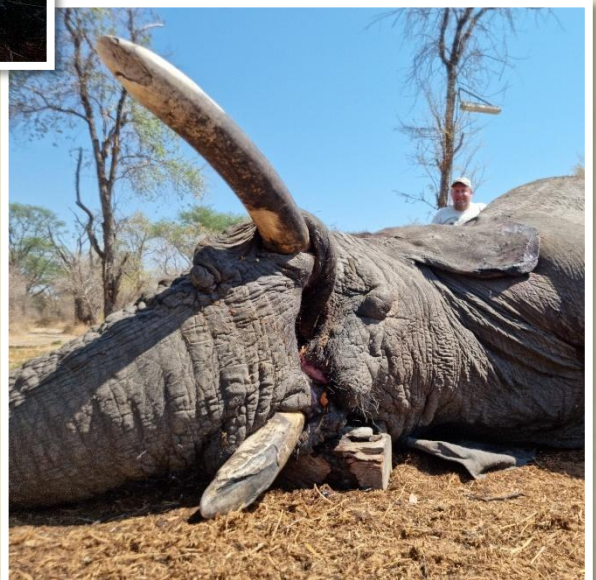
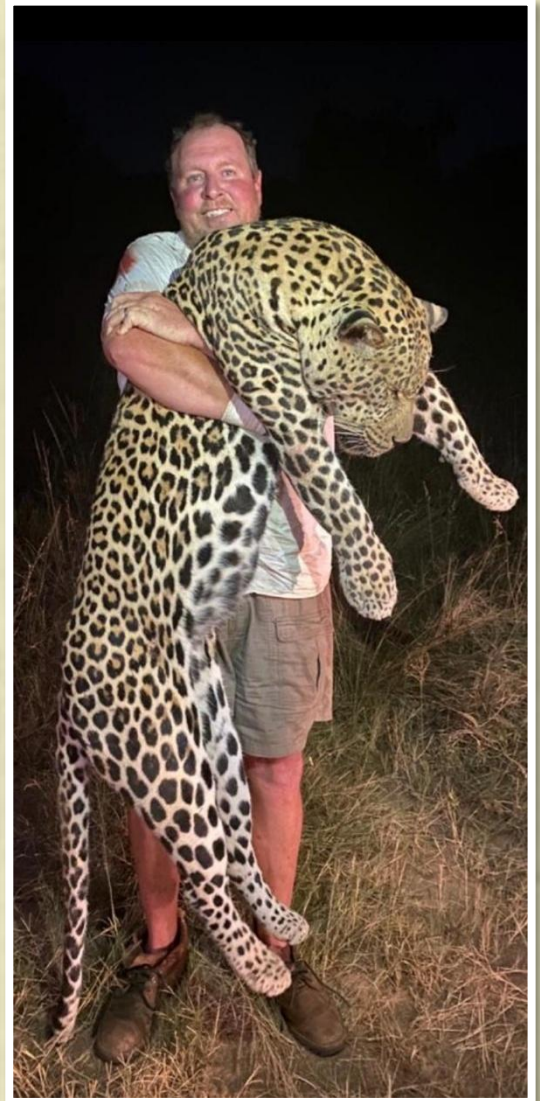

General Information

Travel & Entry Requirements

Austrian, Swiss and German citizens require **NO** visa to enter South Africa.

The following points should be noted:

- The passport must be valid at least 30 days.
- Upon entry, you will need at least 2 blank pages in your passport
- The registered name on the passport must match the name on the ticket, which is especially important for double names or long names.



Vaccinations and Health care

There are excellent Doctors and Hospitals in South Africa, but please consider travel Insurance!

Many hunting destinations in South Africa are Malaria-free.

Vaccinations are NOT mandatory, but we recommend the following for PREVENTION:

- Malaria prophylaxis (necessary in the east of the country, NOT for the Garden Route and Cape Town)
- Hepatitis Prevention
- Polio and Tetanus

For more information about immunizations of any kind you should ask your GP or inquire with the health department, prior to departure!

Currency

The South African currency is the "Rand", which is divided into 100 cents.

We encourage you to travel with Euros in cash and/or Credit Card

All major Hotels and shops accept credit cards.

Please keep in mind that some small businesses do NOT accept Credit Cards.

Time change

Population

220/230 Volt / 50 Hz AC. The socket forms vary, which is why you should have a travel adapter (primarily for the English 3-hole plug system) in your luggage.

In most hotels or lodges these plug systems can be hired.



Climate

South Africa is located south of the equator, between 22- and 34-Degrees South Latitude and thus falls within the scope of the subtropics. In comparison to the Northern Hemisphere, there are opposite seasons. However, in comparison to areas in similar width positions the temperatures are lower in many regions. There is a generally well-tolerated climate for Europeans. The average duration of sunshine is amongst the highest in the world.

On the West Coast the cold Benguela current makes for temperate temperatures. In the central highlands (Johannesburg lies at about 1,650 meters above sea level) temperatures in summer rarely go above 35 ° C.

In winter, temperatures in the central highlands also rise to 35 ° C but can also go below freezing point.

In the coastal regions the temperatures are very moderate to Warm. Rain falls mainly in the South African summer months - This does not apply to the Western Cape region, which is considered winter rainfall region.

Hunting Information

Preparation and shipping of trophies

After a successful hunt, the hunting trophies can be Raw Prep in South Africa. Then you have the choice to send the trophies to a taxidermist of your choice or to have them mounted and finished in South Africa.

We, however, recommend Raw Prep done in South Africa and have it mounted at Home.

Importation of weapons / rifles to South Africa

The importation of arms to South Africa is usually straightforward if the following points are considered:

- Check with your flight booking that you have chosen an airline that transports weapons / rifles!
- Report the weapon / rifle during the booking with the airline company!
- Please send us the following documents and information:

- Copy of your ticket
- Copy of weapon / rifle ownership card
- Copy of your passport
- Your full name, date of birth and physical address

We will send you a booking confirmation / invitation letter that you have to bring with you.

- You must have the following documents when entering South Africa with a rifle:

- Original flight ticket and a copy
- Original weapons / rifle permit and a copy
- Passport and a copy

- Upon arrival at the airport in South Africa you collect your luggage first and then go to the arrival's terminal.

Please note that your

Rifle will not be on the luggage treadmill, but will be brought directly to the South African Police Department / Rifle Control on the Airport.

- Upon entering the Arrivals terminal, a team member of " Carlo Engelbrecht Safaris " will meet you.

Together you will then go to the Police station / rifle control. We will assist you in completing the necessary documents.

- As soon as we've received all the necessary above-mentioned documentation, we will then prepare all the documentation regarding importation of your rifle. As our guest, all you must do is provide your signature.

Rifles

For hunting African game, a minimum of 7mm Caliber is essential.

We recommend caliber 300 Win. Mag, 375H & H or similar caliber.

Please clarify questions about rifle and the caliber upon your booking with us.

We also have the following Calibre rifles that is available to hire: 375H & H, 308, 7mm Rem. Mag 458 .3006

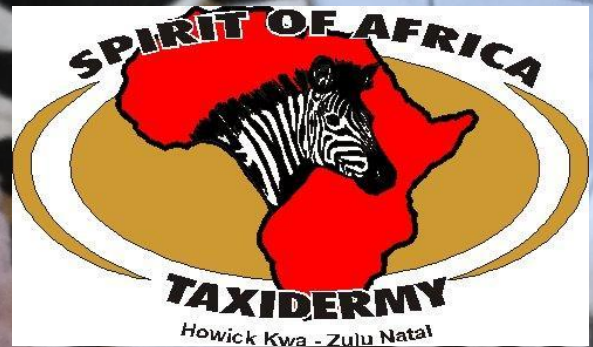
